
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AH! THE PRIDE OF OXFORD



Importance of tree plantation has become even greater because of the growing pollution in the environment. In recognition to this. The students from college contributed generously to the cause. Plants were brought and students planted the saplings themselves. Posters and banners depicting importance of trees have also been designed and placed at prominent places within the college premises. Science teachers have been directed to prepare multimedia presentations embedded with related video clips, images and animations to spread the awareness pertaining to importance of tree plantation.
